Bible Story *Luke 2:1-20*

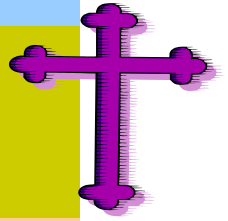
December 26: *When they saw that the star had stopped, they were overwhelmed with joy (Matthew 2:10)*
